

## Past Chairman of the Board (2009-20011)

During Mr. Hubler's term as Chairman of the board for the Phoenixville Regional Chamber of Commerce, the following accomplishments occurred:

- In conjunction with the Borough of Phoenixville, the First Friday program was continued, instead of being dropped for lack of funding/personne l.
- A standing committee of the 5 largest groups (Chamber, Borough,CDC, Paedco and PABA) was established and the benefits of coordinating efforts is only just beginning.
- New Chamber staff was brought in, employee reviews and an updated handbook were approved and rolled into standard operating procedures
- By laws were changed to better fit the current digital age (i.e. electronic voting).
- Chamber Finances and cash flow were greatly improved
- The minimum number of required board members was reduced to be more realistic and allow less, but more active chamber board members.
- The ambassador committee has continued to help new members "find their way" in the chamber and in the business community, this member focused committee was started as the first project Mr. Hubler undertook as then Vice-President.
- The Chamber itself has had a face lift. The empty lot is now a clear and welcoming piece of nature in the middle of bridge street. The chamber office has had a makeover and is now a clean, bright and positive workplace that gives visitors new and old a very good first impression.

In addition to his volunteering as the Chairman of the board for the Phoenixville Chamber, Mr. Hubler also is President of Creative Capital Wealth Management group in that role he has been the recipient of the Philadelphia Business Journal's top wealth management advisors and Philadelphia Magazine's Five Start Wealth manager designations. In 2012 Mr. Hubler won the Main Line Today top advisor of the year award, and has been interviewed by the Wall Street Journal and American Banker in addition to his column in the local Phoenixville newspaper. Mr. Hubler was accepted into the NFL players association registered advisor program in 2008 and is now one of only 270 people who hold that designation.

Mr. Hubler currently serves on the Phoenixville Baseball Committee, and has previously served on the Board of Directors for the Phoenixville Senior Center as Vice-President and has been President of the Kiwanis Club of Phoenixville. As President of the Kiwanis club he was instrumental in the creation of the Kiwanis Children's Plaza, which is used year long to the betterment of Phoenixville area children. He is married to Elizabeth Hubler and has two new additions to his family Abigail and James.
